NRCPD V Registered Sign Language Interpreter

Case Summary

The NRCPD Complaints Committee convened to consider allegations relating to the Registrant's competence. The Panel was informed that the recording of an interpretation contained errors and that the Registrant acknowledged they should have reviewed and re-recorded it to ensure an accurate version was shared.

In light of this admission, NRCPD did not pursue the allegations relating to competence or seek a finding of misconduct or impairment.

Sanction / Resolution

A resolution was proposed in this case, under which the Registrant would undertake 12 months of professional supervision and any recommended training to address the issues raised, with a report to be submitted at the conclusion of this period. The resolution was agreed between the parties and accepted by the Panel.
